

I spy

Place a selection of objects or the pictures from this pack each with two or three phonemes on the table.

Use the sound-talk toy and ask the children to listen as he says 'I spy with my little eye a z-i-p'.

Ask the children to say the name of the object and hold it up. Say the individual phonemes together and blend them together to say the word.

You can use objects with the same initial phoneme for the game when the children are familiar with it to encourage them to listen and blend the whole word rather than just relying on the initial sound.
