

Say the sounds

When the children have become familiar with a toy say words in sound-talk and blending the sounds to make words you can ask them if they can speak in sound-talk.

Choose some objects with three phonemes in each, or use the pictures in the pack and hide them in a box.

Let a child choose an object and ask them to say the separate sounds in sound-talk. The other children can then blend the sounds together to make the word.

The game could also be played by spreading the picture cards face up on the table and asking one child to sound-talk one of the words. The other children must then identify which picture it is by blending the word.
