Is Greenland green?

Substantive Knowledge (key facts)

- Greenland is a country within the Arctic Circle.
- Greenland is much colder than the UK because of this fewer people live there.
- Greenland has no night in summer and no daylight in winter.
- Indigenous people who live in Greenland are known as Inuit. They live very differently to people in the UK.
- Although it is possible to grow hardy vegetables, Greenlanders must import much of their food, clothing, and other necessities.
- As it is very cold, people need to wear thick warm clothing, which is sometimes made from animal fur.

Prior experiences or knowledge learnt

- I know that there are different countries in the world. I can talk about the differences they have experienced or seen in photos.
- I can draw information from a simple map.
- Recognise some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries.
