Concept



Substantive Knowledge (key facts)

- Trade is an important way to make sure that natural resources are shared around the world.
- Fairtrade is an arrangement which aims to ensure that farmers get a fair price for their goods.
- Many items we enjoy can be Fairtrade, but this often means it costs more to buy.
- Fairtrade items include bananas, coffee, and chocolate- support the farmers involved in growing, harvesting, and trading these.

Geography skills I am practising

- Use 4 & 6-figure grid reference to locate features on a map.
- Use a range of maps to locate places.
- Use a range of different maps to help find sources of natural resources.
- Investigate and question sources of information.

Sequence of learning

1)	Immersion Day— showing on a map where different Fairtrade products come from, learning to identify the Fairtrade symbol and taste testing Fairtrade products.
2)	Banana Split game—looking at the (unfair) payment split in the banana supply chain and the impact Fairtrade has on this.
3)	Fairtrade Premium payment— taking on the role of Fairtrade co-operative farmer and deciding how they would spend the Fairtrade premium payment for the benefit of their community
4)	Fairtrade Packaging— researching and designing packaging for a Fairtrade chocolate bar which summarises all our learning on the topic so far.
