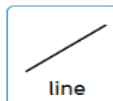
Colour is a way that we describe an object.



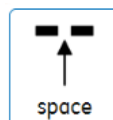
An element of art that is 2 dimensional, flat or limited to height and width.

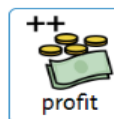
